Why You Need a Will

For many, a will is an expression of stewardship: future planning for the resources God has entrusted to us. However, up to 70% of adults do not have an up-to-date will! Creating or updating your will allows you to:

- Know your will represents what is most important to you.
- Choose the next steward of your resources.
- Determine who will care for your children and how your assets should be distributed.
- Help your favorite nonprofits such as The Path.
- Enjoy peace of mind knowing your financial "house" is in order.
- Ensure your will is still relevant to changes in your family, financial situation, or tax laws.

Questions to Consider
