Dodd applied for and was secured a Vitamins Supplement Grant by the Florida Attorney General's office. After securing the grant, Dodd and the sheriff's office chaplaincy met with leaders from the two shelters to learn about their needs to assist their residents. As a result of the meeting, \$2,500 in nutritious food projects, including meats, frozen fruits and vegetables and cheese was recently split between the two shelters who assist those without proper housing in Citrus County.
