
Our Mission


Our Vision



Since opening the shelter in 2001, THE PATH has been responding to the needs of men, women and children who are without a home by expanding its facilities and developing life-transforming recovery programs. There is no time limit for length of stay as long as The Path's programs meet an individual's goals and needs.

A local 501-c-3, THE PATH has provided shelter and other services to over 1,500 men, women and children.



Healthy Individuals and Communities The Path's Farm Project – "Harvest Hope"

- **2002:** Began back-yard farming to address malnutrition & supplement the shelter's food supply with fresh vegetables.
- **2005:** 10 acres of land loaned for seasonal pesticides-free farming & work program
- **2010:** Launched a Farm Co-op program to provide locally-grown food for community year-round
- **2012:** 5 acres added for growing vegetables using natural farming methods
- **2015:** In partnership with local Rotary Clubs, leased additional 10 acres from county to grow fruit trees



"Harvest Hope" provides a work program for men and women at The Path to improve recovery from addiction and poor physical health.
