## **VOLUNTEER JOB POSITIONS**

### **Current Volunteer needs**

1. Administrative Assistants- General assistance, writing thank-you letters or cards, assembling mailings. Phone skills and computers are required, good communication skills a plus.
2. Path Ambassadors to our community and churches (2-3 people)- liaison between The Path & organization/church to help network our needs and events to churches and organizations in the community; motivate support and participation for Path drives (clothing, food, etc.) and other projects.
3. Administrative/receptionists- ad hoc, greet office guests & direct donations. Help w/ phone calls, mailings, filing, etc. Computer skills with Windows and Microsoft office applications (Word, Excel) a plus.
4. Bargain store cashiers- greet customers, ring up cash & credit card purchases
5. Handy Man/General Maintenance- to help with maintaining properties and facilities.

### **Direct client contact (orientation & volunteer application required):**

1. Transportation- help with transporting clients to appointments, can use Path vehicles.
2. Farm Volunteers- Help with transplanting seedlings. Supervise to make sure crops are watered, fertilized, weeded and growing properly, must know how to grow crops on an acreage scale. Current farmland is 15 acres.

3. Assistant Program Coaches- train for back up support to Parenting, Effective Employment Search, Budgeting, GED preparation, or Nutrition Basics, plus any other program leads as needed or implemented.
4. Women's Bible study instructor- Run weekly bible study at the shelter for women only. 2 hours.
5. Men's Bible study instructor- Run weekly bible study at the shelter for men only. 2 hours.
6. Men's and Women's Counselors- Biblically-based counseling, as scheduled, weekly with designated male or female clients as applicable and appropriate.
7. Male & Female Leaders for Christian 12-Step program- facilitate weekly 1 hour classes from the Life Recovery series. Classes held at The Path. Separate classes for men only and women only.
8. Computer Basics Instructor- Teach weekly classes and test clients on basic computer operation, email, and Microsoft Office applications (Word, Excel). Use our curriculum or provide your own.
9. Wood Refinisher- to help refinish wood products and teach the men how to refinish. 5 hours a week to take old wood products and refinish them to be sold, must be able to use tools and know wood.
